Melcher-Dallas School Board Director At Large – To Fill Vacancy – Allen Rogers


Melcher-Dallas School Public Measure - Proposition A (text below) – Approved

Shall the Board of Directors of the Melcher-Dallas Community School District in the County of Marion, State of Iowa, be authorized to contract indebtedness and issue General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$5,725,000 to provide funds to build, furnish, and equip a new gymnasium at the junior high/high school facility, including locker rooms, athletic facilities, classrooms, and related facility improvements; and including demolition of the existing gymnasium and attached classrooms; and related site improvements?
