Public Comments:

Business:

1. The Marion County Librarians presented their FY23 budget funding request of \$100,000 to the Board. The presentation includes activities reports from each of the 5 libraries. Jahner moved and McCombs seconded to close discussion.

2. McCombs moved and Jahner seconded to approve Resolution 2022-15: Acceptance of 184th Place into Secondary Road System for Maintenance (Hunter's Ridge Addition – Plat 5) as follows:

Whereas, Hunters Ridge subdivision Plat 5 is an approved plat in Marion County and;

Whereas, the roads, storm sewer, and related appurtenances constructed have been constructed and comply with the County's standards for 184th Place, platted as Lot A;

Whereas, the county is responsible to maintain only roads that are accepted into the county's secondary road system by the Board of Supervisors;

Now therefore be it Resolved, the roads constructed as part of Plat 5, 184th Place (Lot A) of Hunters Ridge Subdivision and applicable storm sewer easements be accepted into the Marion County Road system.

3. McCombs moved and Jahner seconded to receive and file the Marion County Treasurer's FY21/22 Semi-Annual Report. (7/1/2021 - 12/31/2021)

4. Chris Nesteby, Marion County Facilities Director updated the Board regarding VA Demolition project. Nesteby noted the boiler abatement tests were completed and there were no more brick give aways. Jahner moved and McCombs seconded to close discussion.


