Jahner moved and Mc Combs seconded to reduce FY23 Levy Rate for General Supplemental (02000) to 2.20107 from 2.40107.

Mc Combs moved and Jahner seconded to accept Local Option Sales and Service Tax as presented:

Fund 29000 – 50%

Fund 01000 – 30%

Fund 02000 – 20%

Discussion regarding employee Health Insurance benefit carrier options and plan structures to reduce increased cost to County. No increase in Vision plan or Flex Fees foreseen.

Raymie moved and Jahner seconded to recess.

Mc Combs moved and Jahner seconded to reconvene from recess at 2:00 p.m.


