Business:

1. Jahner moved and McCombs seconded to approve Resolution 2022-32 Appointment of Marion County Recorder as follows:

Whereas, the Marion County Recorder, Karen Schwanebeck resigned effective April 4, 2022, and

Whereas, pursuant to Section 69.14A The Board of Supervisors has the authority to fill a vacancy in the office of County Recorder by appointing a successor or by calling a special election, and

Whereas, pursuant to Section 69.14A(2)(a)(2) a petition may be filed by the public within fourteen days of the notice of publication or within fourteen days after the appointment is made to call a special election to fill said vacancy by appointment.

Now Therefore Be It Resolved by the Marion County Board of Supervisors that they have appointed Naomi Ellis as the successor to fill in as the Marion County Recorder effective 4:30 P.M. on April 4, 2022 until an elected candidate takes office after the November 8, 2022 Election.

The Board publicly thanked retiring Marion County Recorder Karen Schwanebeck for her years of service at the County.


Steve McCombs reported he would be attending a County Zoning work session this week. He will also be attending a special Cedar Creek Watershed meeting and the future of the program was in doubt.
