Lincoln St. Knoxville, IA 50138 on Wednesday, November 12, 2025, with Steve McCombs, Kisha Jahner and Jim Mueller present in-person. Board of Supervisor Chair Jahner opened the regular session at 9:00 A.M. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Agenda:

Mueller moved and McCombs seconded to approve the agenda as posted.

Communications:

McCombs moved and Mueller seconded to approve the consent agenda as follows:

3. Mueller moved and McCombs seconded to approve Marion County Resolution 2025-91 Marion County Junction 92 Project – Change Order #8 as follows:

WHEREAS; on November 28, 2023 Marion County received bids for the Marion County Maintenance Facility (the “Project”) described as the main shop at the Road Department’s Junction 92 Facility; and;

WHEREAS; Breiholz Construction Co. has been presented the change order Calhoun Burns & Associates and FRK Architects-Engineers, P.C. worked with Marion County on to propose the changes following the issues that have arose;

WHEREAS; Marion County reviewed and accepted the Proposal Requests #21;

WHEREAS; the requests result in a net increase of \$1,412.36 to the contract amount;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED; that Marion County approve Change Order No. 8 of \$1,412.36 for the Project with; Breiholz Construction resulting in a change in the contract sum from \$5,597,506.60 for the construction of a new Road Department shop in Marion County, IA to \$5,598,918.96.

Note – Brian Hatch, Marion County Road Department, provided an update on the slow progress of the project and possible completion dates.

4. The Board discussed a contribution request from the Iowa State Association of Counties (ISAC) regarding an amicus brief that requests the Supreme Court of the United States hear the case of Couser v. Shelby County, Iowa about pipelines. McCombs moved and Jahner seconded to approve the contribution request of \$500 in an attempt to protect Local Control by Counties.




Jahner – Salary study is progressing, Board of Health meeting, Pleasantville FFA building a BOS metal sign
