## Resolution relating to the construction of confinement feeding operations.

**WHEREAS**, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a board of supervisors wishes to adopt a “construction evaluation resolution” relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

**WHEREAS**, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

**WHEREAS**, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR’s decision regarding a specific application; and

**WHEREAS**, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the board of supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the board of supervisors between February 1, 2026 and January 31, 2027 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

**WHEREAS**, the board of supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board’s recommendation to the DNR may be based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF MARION COUNTY** that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

## 28. Resolution 2026-17 Township Trustee and Clerk Compensation

**Whereas**, *Iowa Code* Section 359.46 requires the Marion County Board of Supervisors to establish compensation for a township trustee, and *Iowa Code* section 359.47 states that a township clerk shall be compensated at the same rate of pay as a township trustee and;

**Whereas**, the Marion County Board of Supervisors shall establish a minimum daily pay rate for the time spent by a township trustee and township clerk attending a scheduled meeting of township trustees; and

**Now, Therefore, Be It Hereby Resolved**, by the Marion County Board of Supervisors that pursuant to *Iowa Code* sections 359.46 and 359.47 the minimum daily pay rate for the time spent by a township trustee and by a township clerk attending a scheduled meeting of township trustees is set at \$15.00 per meeting, effective immediately.

**Be It Further Resolved**, a township trustee and a township clerk requesting compensation shall complete necessary County documents and submit a completed meeting claim sheet to the Marion County Auditor.
