General Requirements

<p>*Civilian front escort with mounted height pole required entire route if height exceeds 14' 4".</p> <p>*See General Provisions for escort requirements for overwidth vehicles.</p> <p>*Amber revolving light/strobe light with 360 degree visibility required entire route.</p> <p>*Red of orange fluorescent flag required on rear projection</p> <p>*Amber revolving light/strobe required on rear projection</p> <p>*Overdimensional signs and flags must be displayed on all overdimensional loads over 75 feet long or over 8 feet 6 inches wide or over 14 feet 4 inches high.</p> <p>*Centerline all bridges: primary at 5 mph.</p> <p>*Load must slow or stop when necessary to avoid approaching traffic when centerlining.</p> <p>*No travel on interstate highways.</p> <p>*Prior to move, check with the Department to determine if any roadway changes have occurred by calling 641-828-2225.</p>	<p>*Must carry copy of permit and general provisions dated 10-01 and comply with them.</p> <p>*Speed limit: maximum posted limits unless otherwise specified on permit.</p> <p>*Road must be clear of ice and snow and visibility must be at least 1/4 mile.</p> <p>*Necessary city and/or county permits must be obtained separately.</p> <p>*Hazardous materials must be transported in compliance with applicable federal regulations.</p>
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Disclosure Statement: The Information furnished on this application will be used by Marion County to prepare and issue permits. All information applicable to a given permit is required and is public information. Failure to complete the application as required will result in denial of permit. Permit issuing authorities will not be responsible for any damages that are the result of the move. The State of Iowa, the Iowa Department of Transportation, and any other permit issuing authority assume no responsibility for the property of the permit holder.

Special Conditions which apply to overweight.

- 1.) Trips on seal coat roads are to be reported to the County prior to and immediately following all moves and will require special written approval during periods of spring thaw and extreme heat as determined by County authority.
- 2.) All bridge weight, width, and height postings shall be complied with.
- 3.) Should a trip be necessary on any gravel road during weather conditions where a wheel rut will be created, it shall be the responsibility of the permit holder to notify the County prior to and immediately following all moves, with special written approval required during periods of spring thaw and extreme wet conditions as determined by County authority.
- 4.) Any damage to any roadway caused by the permittee by not taking reasonable care as determined by the county, the permittee shall be responsible for the cost of repairs.
- 5.) Level B and C roads (dirt) are not covered by this permit.
- 6.) Any condition of this permit not met will result in immediate revocation of permit.
