<b>Thomas Barnett with Region VII Disaster Health Response Ecosystem</b>	<p>Region VII is an Asper Tracie funded site. They cover Iowa, Nebraska, Kansas and Missouri. The goal is to get all states covered, but we are currently one of four regions. Started in 2018.</p> <p>Region VII provides training through out the region include webinars to provide education to the service areas. They provide a pediatric medial operations coordination that assists with bed placement and now working on telehealth platforms. Region VII works closely with the HPP coordinators across each state.</p> <p>Currently Region VII has a chemical specialty team and burn teams. This includes work through the poison control centers. Currently work is being done on a regional burn plan and in August will have a tabletop exercise.</p>

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	<p>A trauma team has developed a working group to get trauma centers talking. A radiation team has been working to get education and information out – currently they are working on some just in time training.</p> <p>They are here to help and want to make sure you are ready to respond. ### Jody Koffman:

Reported that they are currently reviewing the PHEP NOFO and plans for the next 5 years. The SOP is also being reviewed and work is being completed around Governing Documents. Look for a Preparedness Newsletter to be coming out from Iowa HHS. Reminder that the Chemical Annex Draft is due on the CAT by April 1<sup>st</sup>.

### Diana Von Stein:

Emails have been going out about measles and currently they are receiving between 1 to 2 consults a week. Reminder that if a provider is considering sending a sample in to make sure they reach out first. They are asking Public Health partners to be prepared if needed. The state continues to see respiratory cases primarily with Influenza B but the wastewater tests show some Influenza A. The state did change some Covid-19 guidance for the public. They are working on video follow-up to track and monitor patients. Diana will be in contact to set up some site visits prior to the end of the fiscal year.
